HICKORY WOOD WARRANTY DISCLAIMER AND RELEASE

The appeal of Manor House cabinetry made from hickory comes from the beauty of the wood.

The hickory used to build Manor House cabinetry will vary in color from shades of off-white to gray to dark brown in areas. Unlimited mineral streaks, where the wood has absorbed minerals from the soil, and small peck marks are normal. Grain patterns and texture will vary from "even" to "relatively wild." The color of the wood used to build the door frames may vary from the color of the wood in the door panels, but it will be similar. The variations in the wood will be visible when cabinets are finished natural or with a colored stain. These variations are considered normal, natural characteristics inherent in the wood.

These variations in the wood will appear throughout all of the cabinets. They will occur on adjacent cabinets, between pairs of doors and/or drawers on the same cabinet, or even within the same panel. The effect of such variations in an entire room will most likely be quite different from what is shown on a small display or a finish sample.

By signing this Waiver, I/we acknowledge that the variations inherent in hickory wood have been explained to me/us, and I/we understand that Rich Maid cannot guarantee the appearance or the uniformity of the hickory wood used to build my/our Manor House cabinetry.
